



AUTOMATED TRAFFIC SURVEILLANCE AND CONTROL SYSTEM– SAN DIEGO FREEWAY

Owner: Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA)

Cost: \$22.1 million

This \$400-million design/build project involved a widening of 12 miles of the freeway to increase better flow of traffic and add HOV lanes. This was accomplished by adding new bridges and ramps. Including new retaining walls, relocation of utilities, installation of new signs, lighting and signals, and a substantial amount of roadway grading and earthwork fills were done. In addition a new fiber optic cable was installed to support ITS, and utilization of CCTV . Steiny also installed a new Changeable Message Signs systems which interfaced with Caltrans as well as local DOT Agencies.
