CCA ADMISSIONS

Coastal Christian Academy exists to help prepare children to be disciples of Jesus Christ. CCA STATEMENT OF FAITH

The Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of all mankind, is the sole and final source of all that we believe. Ultimately, CCA belongs to God and it is our commitment to do His will in all circumstances.
