Call to Confession 1 John 1:8-10

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Prayer of Confession

(adapted from *The Valley of Vision*)

O heavenly Father,

Teach us to see that if Christ has pacified your wrath and satisfied your divine justice he can also deliver us from our sins. Remind us often that you do not desire us, as justified sons and daughters, to live in self-confidence and rest on our own strength. You have given us the Spirit of life to live within us and to cause us to want to obey you; the Spirit and his power are ours because we are joined to Christ by faith.

Father, we are often confused by the sin that remains even though your Spirit dwells in us. We do not love others well, and we cannot come close to loving as we have been loved by you in Jesus. We make very small progress in holiness, and each new day seems to reveal more sin in us that we saw before. Help us to understand that the Spirit of life within us speaks to the law on our behalf and cancels the power of sin and death. We thank you, Holy Father, for giving your precious Son to die for our sin, and for crediting us with all of his glorious perfections, even as we continue to sin daily.

Holy Spirit, flood our souls with gratitude for the precious blood of Christ. When you strengthen us to obey, let us thank you for it and see your hand in it, lest we take credit for your work and grow proud. Give us grace to admit what is true about us, and grace to see what is true about Christ. Teach us to love one another freely, just as we have been cherished by our heavenly Father. May obedience to him be our greatest goal and highest honor, and gratitude our reason to strive for obedience time and time again. In the name and for the glory of Jesus Christ we pray, amen.
