We thank you for his life of perfect obedience and flawless worship on our behalf. He loved, honored, worshiped, and obeyed you with all his heart, soul, mind, and strength, and now his record has replaced our own. In him we are counted as perfect worshipers, and we fall before you and praise you for this wonderful gift of his righteousness.

Holy Spirit, stir our cold and lazy hearts with gratitude. Open our eyes to see all that is ours in Christ, until we can't stop praising him. May the knowledge of what we deserve, and the reality of what we have received, melt our stony hearts with joy, fill our dull minds with unbearable delight, and adorn our lips with exuberant praise. Help us to grow as worshipers, until the day we join the angels dressed in festival robes and gather around your throne to honor you as your righteous children made perfect in Christ. In his strong name we pray, amen.

### \*Confession of Faith

### **Westminster Confession of Faith**

Q 21. Christians, what do we believe about worship?

A. I. The light of nature showeth that there is a God, who hath lordship and sovereignty over all; is good, and doeth good unto all; and is therefore to be feared, loved, praised, called upon, trusted in, and served with all the heart, and with all the soul, and with all the might. But the acceptable way of worshiping the true God is instituted by Himself, and so limited by His own revealed will, that he may not be worshiped according to the imaginations and devices of men, or the suggestions of Satan, under any visible representation or any other way not prescribed in the holy Scripture.

II. Religious worship is to be given to God, the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost; and to Him alone: not to angels, saints, or any other creature: and since the fall, not without a mediator; nor in the mediation of any other but of Christ alone.
